

# Derrick Skating Club

## Commitments Policy – 2019/2020

All DSC Members (Private Figure Skating & IFSA) are required to contribute to club operations throughout the skating year through assistance in 2 separate volunteering capacities. For the 2019-2020 Season, there is no fundraising requirement in lieu of the Competition Volunteering requirement.

### Club Volunteering

Each DSC family must commit to one (1) Club volunteer shift for the 2019/2020 season. Each shift lasts 1-2 hours. All volunteer opportunities will be posted on the Uplifter Registration site. Shifts are filled on a first come, first served basis.

Any part (or all) of your volunteer shifts that remain unfulfilled by August 15, 2020 is considered an incomplete shift. All incomplete shifts will be billed to your credit card on file at a rate of \$50/shift and you will be notified of the same via an email from the office. Any outstanding fees from one annual year must be paid in full or else registration for the next year cannot take place. \*NOTE: That by agreeing to this policy, you are agreeing that your credit card on file can be billed (with notice to you) for your unfulfilled commitments.

### Competition Volunteering

The Derrick Skating Club has been chosen to host the 2020 STARSkate & Adult Championships alongside our Skate Canada: Alberta-NWT/Nunavut Section. This event will take place on the March 20-22, 2020 weekend with a few shifts available before the start of the event. Save the date on your calendar!

Each Competition shift lasts approximately 4 hours. All volunteer opportunities will be posted on the Uplifter Registration site as the competition schedule and shifts are finalized (early 2020) and all members will be receiving an email reminding them to sign up. Shifts are filled on a first come, first served basis.

In support of this event, each DSC family must commit to the following competition volunteer shifts for the 2019/2020 season.

- IFSA Families – 1 shift required
- Private Skater Families – 2 shifts required plus 1 ice patching shift (for all skaters 10 years and older only)

For the 2019-2020 Season, all skating registrations will have a Competition Volunteering Deposit added, per family at a rate of \$100/volunteer shift. For IFSA - \$100 deposit and for Private Skater families - \$200. The deposit will be collected automatically on your first invoice for the Fall/Winter registration.

Following the competition in March 2020, all competition shifts will be reconciled and all families who have completed their requirements will have their deposits credited to their member accounts on or about April 10, 2020 prior to the start of the 2020 Summer skating registration.

### Fundraising

Fundraising activities are an important source of income and are essential to ensuring the Club can maintain affordable program fees and offer high quality programs. In the 2019-2020 Season, the Derrick Skating Club is co-hosting the STARSkate and Adult Championships which will provide a source of revenue in the form of a Hosting Grant in lieu of Fundraising.

FundScrip Gift Card purchasing will continue to be offered as an optional opportunity for families who wish to continue to support the Club through the purchase of their gift cards. FundScrip offers hundreds of gift card options such as groceries, gas, restaurants, movies and much more.
