Sign up to the Club Google Classroom (if you have not yet)

1. Download the Google Classroom App to your device/tablet OR go to classroom.google.com on your computer. Click Go to **Classroom** or click the waffle icon  in the top right corner & find the Google Classroom icon.

2. Enter yours/your child's personal email address to access (note that student school gmail accounts will not work).

3. Class code: e6mvmkko

- If you have any difficulties getting set up, please reach out to the office for assistance or to get an email invite.
- Any email address can be registered for Google use.

Once in Google classroom you can click on "Stream" to find links and what's new OR "Classwork" to find posted resources. Once signed up, you will also receive the updates with Zoom Meeting links (for virtual classes) as they are posted!
